## Co-ordinate game [Sheet 2]-Instructions

- Child closes their eyes to fully concentrate.
- Read the sequence of co-ordinates out twice only and clearly.
- Child memorises the sequence and places counters on the grid.
- Read out aloud so he/she can check.
- If they have placed a wrong counter down, he/she then places it in the correct position to see what it looks like.
- The same sequence is repeated until they are correct. (If this appears to be difficult try with 2 co-ordinates)
(Note-these co-ordinates are in alphabetical order)

1) $A 1, C 3, D 1$
2) $\mathrm{B} 2, \mathrm{D} 2, \mathrm{G} 4$
3) $A 6, B 6, D 3$
4) $\mathrm{C} 4, \mathrm{D} 2, \mathrm{E} 6$
5) E3, F3, G1
(If your child is comfortable try 4 co-ordinates in alphabetical order)
6) $\mathrm{B} 6, \mathrm{D} 4, \mathrm{~F} 6, \mathrm{G} 1$
7) C3, E5, F2, G3
8) B2, D2, E2, F1
9) C4, D4, F1, G6
10) A1, B3, C1, F5
