Team Teach Lesson Delivery:

All staff have taken part in team teaching lessons with Mr Johnston during the 2016-2017 academic year (Staff Completed team teach performance sheets). Here staff develop their skills and confidence in teaching PE with ongoing team teaching throughout the academic school year. This has been done once per half term by all staff with staff meetings where necessary.

This recorded evidence of staff that team teach every half term through observation and analysis performance sheet allows all staff to develop their knowledge and understanding of new PE scheme of work and new national curriculum.
